

Nathan Hale High School Peers with Purpose

Students from Nathan Hale High School and West Allis Central High School attended a full-day training to prepare for Peers with Purpose at the school administration building on April 19, 2013.

The training included learning about how to present information to youth about alcohol and other substance abuse, how to answer youth questions and how to become peer mentors.



After the training, the Peer group presented 12 programs to over 300 middle school students at Frank Lloyd Wright Intermediate School (FLW) on April 25, 2013.

Students at FLW were given pretests before the Peers program that 58% of the students passed. After the Peers presentations, 97% of the students passed the post test.
