# 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Safe and Sober Spring Family Night



The 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Safe and Sober program was held on September 21, 2015 at West Allis Central with 200 parents and students attending. Working in collaboration, the West Allis Police Department, the West Allis West Milwaukee School District, and the West Allis-West Milwaukee Community Coalition presented information to parents and students on making positive choices and having a safe homecoming and school year. The speaker for the program was Jenny Addis who shared her very powerful story about becoming a quadriplegic from a drunken driving accident.

Gift certificates from nine local businesses, including restaurants, hair and nail salons, florists and tanning salons were raffled at the end of the program. Students who attended the family night with their parents/guardians received a \$10 voucher, which can be used toward one event (homecoming, winter formal, or prom).





Youth members from the West Allis-West Milwaukee Community Coalition presented information about the Family Pledge that was then signed by over 100 families in attendance. The youth also launched the Parents Who Host, Lose the Most campaign. The yard signs, posters and window clings form Parents Who Host are a reminder for parents not to hold underage drinking parties and for youth to have a safe and sober homecoming and school year.
